Registration opens at your school office at 8am on Monday, December 10th and closes at 4:00 on Thursday, December 20th, or as classes fill. See class descriptions for dates, times, and cost.

Please pay separately for each class. Make checks payable to PGUSD. If paying with cash, please have exact amount.

Registration deadline is Thursday, December 20th, but classes can fill prior to deadline. Classes are kept at manageable size with minimum and maximum enrollment to ensure the best experience for all participants.

Enrollment is based on date/time stamp of registration receipt.

Plan to begin classes the week of January 8th (The day school resumes!) unless you are notified your enrollment request cannot be accommodated.

If your child is enrolled in BASRP, please notify them when you enroll your child in ASE courses. Please pick up your child promptly after classes. Children not picked up promptly at the end of class will be taken to BASRP (daycare) and you will be charged.

Complimentary bus transportation is offered to take students Mon/Tues/Wed to attend ASE classes. Please complete the Bus Pass application and submit it with registration. Transportation makes every effort to arrive on time, however unexpected bus demands can occur that will affect getting your child to class in a timely manner.

Ballet Beginners (grades 1 & 2) FLORENCE WONG DAVI 3:20-4:20 RHD Ottertorium \$50

Beginners will start with learning the basic steps of ballet. The class will be divided into floor work, barre, center, adagio, allegro and reverence. Students will perform simple combinations at slow and andante tempo, and will also learn: plié, tendu, élevé, supple, retire, sauté, gallops, skips, reverence, port de bras, first, second and third feet position. We will learn different tempos in ballet music, along with well recognized music such as the Nutcracker and Swan Lake. Outfit: Dance leotard or blouse, tights and socks.

Comedy "Improv is a form of theater where most or all of what is created is performed by the players "on the spot". Students will learn to think on their feet, listen and respond, tell stories, and have fun! No experience necessary.

Theater Arts (grades 1 & 2) "Creative Play" MARIA DAWSON 3:20 - 4:05 RHD Ottertorium \$60

This 45 minute process-based class will focus on theatre skills, imagination, self-expression, movement, stage presence, vocal exercises and FUN!

Ceramics (grades 3 - 5) RITIKA KUMAR 3:20-4:20 FG E-1 \$75

Students in this class will learn the basic methods of hand building such as Coiling, Pinching, Building with slab and sculpting clay. Finished artwork will be glazed and fired up in the kiln.

Jazz and Hip Hop (grades 1 - 3) FLORENCE WONG DAVI 3:20 - 4:20 FG Multipurpose Room \$60

In this is an energetic and fun dance class, students will develop their own style as a jazz dancer and learn about street dance (hip-hop). This class is created for kids with great energy and those who want to learn footwork, big leaps and quick turns and up rocks moves=standing up. Yoga (grades 1 - 5) RITIKA KUMAR 2:10-3:10 RHD Cafeteria \$60

Come join in for a playful, non-competitive yoga experience to promote coordination, flexibility, focus, balance and mindfulness. This class will focus on helping kids practice gentle movements in a fun way.

Level 1 - Ukulele (grades 4 & 5) LISA LAVIN 2:10-3:10 RHD Ottertorium \$60

In this six-week course, students will learn the basics of playing the ukulele, from tuning (G, C, E, A) and basic rhythm and strumming. By week 6, students will be able to play 4-6 chords, which will allow them to play (and sing, if they wish) a wide variety of familiar songs. Bring your ukulele or one can be purchased at The Bookmark in Pacific Grove where they will have entry level Tanara ukulele's available for purchase for \$44.95 plus tax. Your student will also need a Clip On Digital Ukulele Tuner.
